City of Menomonie to host Clean Sweep Hazardous Waste Collection September 21, 2023

The collection is open to residents in the City of Menomonie and Towns of Menomonie and Red Cedar.

MENOMONIE, WI (September 2023) – The City of Menomonie will be hosting a Clean Sweep Hazardous Waste Collection event on Thursday, September 21, 2023 from 2:00-6:00 PM. The collection will be held at the City of Menomonie Community Services Building located at 621 11th Avenue West/Highway 29. The hazardous waste collection is open to residents in the City of Menomonie and Towns of Menomonie and Red Cedar. The cost to participate is \$10/vehicle, payable by cash or check.

Acceptable items include antifreeze, brake fluid, degreasers, gasoline and gas/oil mixes, rechargeable batteries smaller than a car battery in size, compact, U-shaped and circular fluorescent light bulbs, fluorescent tube lights, HID lamps, LED lights, PCB and non-PCB ballasts, concrete cleaners, polish and spot removers, pool chemicals, aerosol cans with product still remaining, acids, bases, rodent bait, mercury, mercury containing items (thermostats, thermometers, etc), oil and lead based paint, oil based stains and polyurethanes, adhesives, turpentine, strippers, thinners, insecticides, herbicides, fungicides, rodenticides, fertilizer with weed killer and more. This is not an inclusive list of acceptable and unacceptable items. If you have questions on specific items, please contact the City of Menomonie.

Residents participating in the Clean Sweep Hazardous Waste collection should enter at the north entrance of the City of Menomonie Community Services Building via Wilson Avenue West. Residents will be asked to remain in their vehicles during the collection. The contracted vendor will unload all vehicles.
